CALL FOR RESEARCH POSTER COMPETITION ABSTRACTS

NCICP is sponsoring the biennial **National Conference from November 13-15, 2019** at the Ala Moana Hotel in Honolulu, Hawaii. The NCICP Planning Committee invites you to submit a poster abstract describing a research study, case study, or practice innovation in the areas of professional practice or education. A review process will be completed to determine winning abstracts. Selected abstract presenters will receive a prize covering one registration cost per poster, for the 2019 NCICP conference. A total of 10 posters will be selected.

Requirements (please read carefully):

- Abstract content should address current research and/or clinical practice issues, with a focus in the area of **Immunizations and Disease Prevention through Immunizations**.
- Research must have been initiated and/or completed within the past five years.
- Research in progress and completed are eligible.
- All types of research are encouraged from exploratory to experimental.
- Funding sources should be noted on the abstract.
- Use of product brand names is allowed in the body of the abstract and in the poster presentation.
- The manufacturer/sponsor should be identified by city and state when first mentioned. Subsequent references do not require further identification of the manufacturer/sponsor.
- One abstract submission per individual will be accepted.
- Students are encouraged to submit.
- In cases of multiple authors, the author who will present the poster at the conference is to be listed as the first or primary author.
- Posters will be displayed **in a 3-foot wide** area. More specifications will be provided if selected.

Selection of Abstracts:

- Abstracts will be reviewed and selected by qualified peer reviewers on the conference planning committee. Preference will be given to posters that fit into the conference theme, “Navigating from Local to Global”, and involve current topics of immunization across the lifespan.
- Selection will be based on clarity, logical consistency, and coherency of research.
- Unless specified, the first author is requested to be present at the conference with the poster exhibit.

- The abstract is to be typed, single-spaced on one 8 ½” x 11” sheet of paper with one-inch margins on all sides.
- Use 12 point font size, Arial or Times New Roman.
- The heading must include the title of the presentation in CAPITAL LETTERS, the author’s names (with first names first and surnames last), affiliation, city and state.
- The title should be limited to ten (10) words and clearly indicate the nature of the subject.
- Abstracts may be submitted via email to cbaldwin@hawaii.edu
- Do not send poster session materials with the abstract.
- Be sure to complete the information on the attached abstract cover sheet to submit with your abstract.

Please submit abstracts by **May 20, 2019**, to be included in the review process.
